



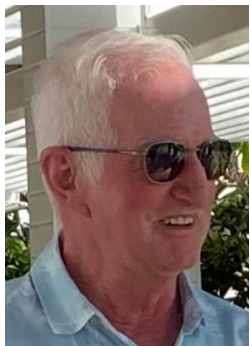
# 2025 Camping at the Moosic Muster

As the muster draws nearer, we are taking this opportunity to welcome Campers in advance and advise the camping rules required by our insurers. You will no doubt have seen many festivals being cancelled due to insurance issues around camping, but after much work (and expense) we have been able to obtain insurance for our event from the UK. Campground meet our responsibilities the following rules apply:

1. The laneways connecting the campgrounds must be kept clear for emergency access and campers are requested to camp to the edges as we did last year.
2. All trip hazards must have an accompanying solar light (available for purchase from camp committee for \$5 if you do not have them).
3. Consumption of alcohol is permitted but responsible behaviour is required.
4. Dogs are allowed but must be on leash or caged when in the campground.
5. Speed limits of 5kmp apply to campground and if you require your car during the event, you must park to the outside where possible
6. No campfires permitted
7. Registration is at the hall and campers must wear lanyards at all times to indicate payment (no free camping permitted)
8. Beware of falling tree limbs. Our beautiful trees give us shade but can be unpredictable. Take care when setting up your campsite and look up
9. Where security events occur, please advise the camp committee who will contact the police
10. Generator use is permitted between 8am and 11pm
11. If quiet camping is required, please ask the camp committee for directions to the quieter areas
12. The camp committee as shown below oversee the campground to ensure a great experience for all, please follow their guidance and pay these wonderful volunteer's great respect.
